Executive Order No. 01-2019

RECONSTITUTING THE MUNICIPAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT-CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION AND MITIGATION COUNCIL (MDRRM-CCAMC) IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF CAMALIG, ALBAY, PROVIDING FOR ITS COMPOSITION AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES

WHEREAS, it is a declared policy of the state to uphold the people' constitutional rights to life and property by addressing the root causes of vulnerabilities to disasters, risk reduction and management and building the resilience of local communities to disasters including climate change impacts;

WHEREAS, under Section 468 (a)(1)(iv) of the Local Government Code (RA 7160), it is the duty of the Municipal Government to adopt measures to protect the inhabitants of the municipality from the harmful effects of man-made or natural disasters and calamities and to provide relief services and assistance for victims during and in the aftermath of said disaster and calamities;

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10121 was enacted by Congress on February 1, 2010 otherwise known as the "Philippine Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Act of 2010"

WHEREAS, Sec. 11 of said law provides for the organization of the local government level of the disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council and accordingly the existing Municipal Disaster Coordinating Council (MDCC) under PD 1566 shall henceforth be known as Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management-Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation Council (MDRRM-CCAMC);

WHEREAS, Republic Act No.9729 was enacted by Congress on July 27, 2009 otherwise known as the Climate Change Act of 2009;

WHEREAS, Section 14 of said law provides that the LGUs shall be the frontline agencies in the formulation, planning and implementation of climate change action plans in their respective areas, consistent with the provisions of the Local Government Code, the Framework, and the National Climate Change Action Plan;

WHEREFORE, premises considered and by virtue of the power vested in me under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, I, CARLOS IRWIN G. BALDO, Jr. Municipal Mayor of the Municipality of Camalig, Albay, do hereby order the following:

SEC.1 Establishment of MDRRM-CCAMC. – There shall be established in the Municipality of Camalig, Albay, the Municipal Disaster Risk Reduction and Management-Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation Council (MDRRM-CCAMC);

SEC. 2. Reconstituting MDRRM-CCAMC Composition. – The new MDRRM-CCAMC shall be composed of the following:

SEC. 3. Functions. – The MDRRM-CCAMC shall have the following functions:

1. Approve, monitor and evaluate the implementation of the LDRRMP-LCCAP and regularly review and test the plan consistent with other national and local planning programs;
2. Regularly update the LCCAP to reflect changing social, economic, and environmental conditions and emerging issues;
3. Ensure the integration of disaster risk reduction and climate change adaptation into local development plans, programs and budgets as a strategy in sustainable development and poverty reduction;
4. Recommend the implementation of forced or pre-emptive evacuation of local residents, if necessary; and
5. Convene the local council once every three months or as necessary.

SEC. 4. Meetings. – Pursuant to Item No.4 of the LDRRMCs functions, the Council shall hold meetings once every three (3) months or as may be necessary or when called by the Chairperson;

SEC. 5. Secretariat. – Pursuant to Item No. 18 of LDRRMCs functions, the MDRRMO and the Office of the Municipal Social Welfare and Development shall serve as the Secretariat of the Council;

SEC. 6. Amendatory Clause. – This Order amends all existing Local Executive Orders or other previous issuances inconsistent herewith; and

SEC.7. Effectivity. – This Order takes effect upon its issuance.
